Tips for documenting issues or accompanying colleagues to meetings:

- Don't overthink it! You're not responsible for solving all the problems, but rather a union contact for the member.
- Employees have the right to have a union representative present in any meeting that
 could result in discipline or affect their working conditions (Weingarten Rights). In these
 meetings, your role is to take detailed notes of what transpires not to speak on behalf
 of the member. Your role as a steward/rep is also protected by law and you cannot be
 retaliated against.
