16	benefits and services provided by the University to all faculty and Officers of
17	Administration as of the effective date of this Agreement, including, but not limited to:

26	b. Bargaining unit faculty members with appointments 0.50 FTE or greater shall have equal
27	access to the miscellaneous benefits and services provided by the University to all faculty

30	i. Tuition discounts provided through tuition discount program at the University of
31	Oregon for up to 16 credits per term;
32	ii. Professional Development Opportunity Fund;

35	in benefit offering, program terms, and eligibility requirements.

43	Section 3. Bargaining unit faculty members who are using the tuition discount for the
44	undergraduate education of a dependent child will be entitled to a second, concurrent tuition
45	discount for a dependent child to attend undergraduate programs at the University of Oregon.
46	The terms, conditions, eligibility requirements, and discount available applicable to this
47	additional tuition discount will be the same as the terms, conditions, eligibility requirements,
• •	and the second will be all build up the terms, conditions, on ground requirements,

- 48 and discount available under the tuition discount program. If both parents of a dependent child
- 49 are bargaining unit faculty members, a full tuition waiver will be granted at the University of
- 50 Oregon. 51
- 52 Faculty members who have worked for the University of Oregon for 20 years or more, and
- 53 have since retired or left employment in good standing, will remain eligible for a tuition
- 54 discount for the undergraduate education of one dependent child at the University of Oregon.

- 57 tuition discount for credits taken at the University of Oregon shall not be less than 70 percent of
